

## TOUR CONCERT VENUES

### June 20, 2017

Vilnius, St. Catherine's Church—This is one of the first churches completely renovated after Lithuania restored its independence in 1990. During this renovation, the church was transformed into a concert hall and today is one of the major venues for choral and instrumental music events in the area. The space is renowned for its remarkable acoustics.



### June 21, 2017

The hall was built in the 16<sup>th</sup> century and is considered to be one of the first Renaissance style rooms in the Baltic States. Today, the hall is used for various events from prestigious classical concerts to large-scale productions.
