Dear Financial Aid Applicant:

The Preucil School of Music is pleased to be able to offer aid to students in need of financial assistance for instrument lessons and Preschool. Although the funds available for aid are limited, the School works hard to raise funds to award partial aid to those families and students most in need. **There is a limit of two instrument applications per student.**

Financial Aid to current students is given on the basis of the following criteria:

- 1. Financial need of the family.
- 2. Merit based on practice discipline, motivation and a desire to achieve.
- 3. Instrument student has been enrolled at Preucil School or Preucil Preschool in the previous year and/or has been enrolled in at least three (3) Music Together® sessions.
- 4. Recommendation of the student's teacher regarding the student's preparation of lessons and eagerness to learn.
- 5. Active involvement of student and family in Preucil School enrichment activities and volunteer programs.

Financial Aid to new students is given on the basis of the following criteria:

- 1. Financial need of the family.
- 2. Participation in student and family in Preucil School enrichment activities and volunteer programs.

In allocating aid, the Preucil School of Music is recognizing the devoted efforts of caring parents and offering the services of dedicated faculty. This requires an obligation on the part of the applicant to **demonstrate sustained effort in the student's studies if given financial aid**. Such efforts would include careful practice periods (length agreed upon with the teacher) at least six days per week, regular attendance at group lessons, and a strong desire to progress.

Financial Aid students are required to participate in*:

- 1. Group and/or orchestra if a string student and qualifies by age and ability
- 2. Musical Achievement Week
- 3. Annual Reflections and Goal-Setting Process
- 4. Volunteer Program

To apply:

- 1. Please complete the <u>Application Form</u> (3 pages) in entirety for each student; your child needs to sign the <u>Statement of Intent Form</u> as an expression of their commitment.
- 2. Include a copy of pages 1 & 2 of your <u>most recent Federal Income Tax Return</u> (including Schedules 1-6) for the person claiming the student.
- 3. Mail application, tax return and any supporting documentation by <u>May 1, 2023</u> to Preucil School of Music, 524 N Johnson Street, Iowa City, IA 52245 or scan and email all documents to <u>amclaughlin@preucil.org</u>.
- 4. Please ask each of your teachers to complete and submit a <u>Faculty Recommendation Form</u>, which also needs to be submitted to the office by <u>May 1, 2023</u>. (The teacher will turn their form directly into the office.)
- 5. The Financial Aid Committee will **not** consider incomplete applications. Awards will be finalized in May and all applicants will be notified by the end of June.
- 6. Applications with a Federal Adjusted Gross Income over \$150,000 are not eligible for financial aid.
