**The Hanging Basket Sale is a High-Profit Sale.
Each item generates a profit of approximately \$10.50!

The baskets retail for \$25.99 at Isle of Green**

We are asking each student on tour to sell a minimum of 2 baskets. If you can sell more, that would be greatly appreciated! All profit from the sales goes to cover tour expenses.

 - ❖ **Plants are florist quality, grown at Isle of Green Nursery in Marshalltown.**
 - ❖ **Flowers are assorted colors, except the geranium basket is red. The fern is a Boston fern.**
 - ❖ **Pots are 10".**
4. Record clearly all information for each sale so the order will be correctly entered and your delivery will be trouble-free. We recommend payment be collected at the time the order is placed!
